What's going on this summer?

The Manchester Public Library and Manchester Public Schools believe that summer is a wonderful time to develop positive reading habits. Our program will be a little different this year, but it will still include:

Free Summer Reading T-Shirt after reading:

- 10 books - preschool age children
- 5 books - children entering Kindergarten - Gr. 3
- 3 books - children entering Gr. 4-5

Add your name to the Wall of Fame after reading:

- 20 books - preschool age children
- 10 books - children entering Kindergarten - Gr. 3
- 6 books - children entering Gr. 4-5

Claim the final prize after reading:

- 30 books - preschool age children
- 15 books - children entering Kindergarten - Gr. 3
- 9 books - children entering Gr. 4-5



The Teen Summer Reading program is available for Grades 6 and up.

*The first day to log books is June 17th; the first day to pick up prizes at the library is June 21st and the final day for prizes is September 3rd. All prizes while supplies last.

Paper logs are available in the Cheney Children's Room, at Whiton, and to print from our website, beginning June 17th.
