There is a new way to find out what is happening at the library! By downloading the free BluuBeam app to your phone, you can get notifications about programs, databases, special events, and more! So how does it work? There are BluuBeams located in the lobby, at the main entrance of the reference room, in the children's room, and at Whiton. Once you download the app you will receive a message if you are in range of a beam. You will only be sent one notification every 24 hours, so you will not be bombarded with constant messages. Take advantage of this free app and stay in the know!

Summer Reading 2015 is in full swing! Make sure to ask about how you can get started and about this year's events and prizes!



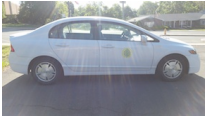
Downloadable Magazines at MPL



Through MPL you can download digital magazines in two different ways. The first way is through Zinio. The Zinio magazine collection consists of 54 volumes that can be easily downloaded to your PC/MAC or to a mobile device. Some titles are available in languages other than English including Spanish and Chinese. There are no limits to how many issues you can check out, and you can keep them in your account indefinitely.

The second way that you can download magazines is through OverDrive. In addition to eBooks and eAudiobooks, OverDrive has added 63 magazines to their collection. To have access to these titles you must first download the NOOK app to your device, and then "send" the titles to the app. You can check out 4 magazines at a time and the magazines will stay in your NOOK account until you remove them.
